## Mercury & Mars | 17th-21st August

The two tiniest planets in the Solar System are having an encounter throughout August. From the 17th to the 21st, these planets will be very close together, appearing as twin bright stars even to the naked eye. Mercury is usually a tough target to locate, but with bright Mars nearby, this might be the perfect time to cross this elusive planet off your bucket list.

**When to look:** 5.30-6pm, 17th to 21st August

**Which direction to look:** Very low to the west

### **SOMETHING INTERESTING**

Due to Mercury's low axial tilt, deep craters at the North and South Pole are so deep that the light of the Sun has never reached the bottom. At these depths, space probes have detected evidence of frozen water ice!

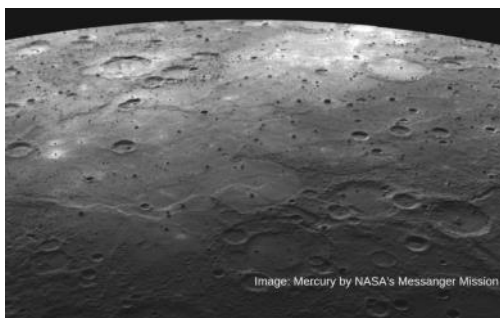


Image: Mercury by NASA's Messenger Mission





**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINARY ELECTION  
CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS  
Shire of Three Springs  
ROLL CLOSE: 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021**

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government elections on 16 October 2021 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Three Springs.

**Residents**

You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll and meet the eligibility criteria, or if you have changed address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

**Enrolment Forms**

Electoral enrolment forms are available from the Shire of Three Springs, all Australian Electoral Commission offices ([www.aec.gov.au](http://www.aec.gov.au)) or the Western Australian Electoral Commission ([www.elections.wa.gov.au](http://www.elections.wa.gov.au)) and must be completed and reach a Divisional Returning Officer in Western Australia by 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021.

**Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers**

If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Three Springs and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote. If you are not on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll and own or occupy rateable property in the Shire of Three Springs you may be eligible to enrol to vote. This applies if you were on the last electoral roll for the Shire of Three Springs prior to May 1996 and have owned or occupied rateable property in the district continuously since this time. Please contact your local government for details. Owners of land who were on the last Local Government roll continue to retain that status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact the Shire of Three Springs to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date of the application to enrol.

**Joint Owners and Occupiers**

If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

**Corporations**

A body corporate that owns or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

**Enrolment Forms – Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Only**

Enrolment forms can be obtained from local governments and must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by 5:00 PM Friday, 27 August 2021. Further information can be obtained from the Shire of Three Springs.

## Boosting Mobile Coverage in Durack

30 July 2021

Durack is set to benefit from new and improved mobile coverage thanks to Round 5A of the Morrison Government's highly successful Mobile Black Spot Program.

Federal Member for Durack, the Honourable Melissa Price welcomed the news that 8 more Mobile Black Spots are set to be addressed under this round of the Program.

"From the Kimberley to the Mid- West there will be improved mobile coverage for the local community, allowing visitors and locals alike to stay connected, access education services, conduct business and remain in contact with family and friends," Ms Price said.

"I look forward to working with the successful recipients so that building the mobile base station can get underway and the community can benefit from improved coverage. These base stations will improve coverage in disaster prone areas, along major transport corridors and trial new approaches to delivering coverage," she said.

The Morrison Government has committed \$20.5 million to fund 67 new mobile base stations across Australia. This announcement brings the total number of base stations being funded under the Mobile Black Spot Program to over 1,270 base stations, representing a total investment of over \$875 million in total investment

The 67 base stations funded under Round 5A across regional and remote Australia will collectively deliver over 12,000 square kilometres of new and improved handheld coverage. The Government is committed continuing to work with industry and state and local governments to improve mobile coverage and connectivity across Australia.

A key priority of Round 5A is to test new approaches to supporting improved mobile coverage.

"The Liberals and Nationals Government encourage mobile network operators to deploy shared mobile infrastructure to reduce cost and provide new coverage from more than one carrier.

## More vital funding for Durack airstrips

More than \$1.7 million across 7 Durack regional airports will benefit from grants under Round 2 of the Morrison Government's Regional Airports Program.

Federal Member for Durack, the Honourable Melissa Price said the grants are vital to assist local regional communities maintain infrastructure and safety standards.

### Avoid car hire headaches

With more of us holidaying at home this year due to ongoing travel restrictions, hiring a rental vehicle can be a great way to explore our vast state.

Unfortunately things don't always go to plan, with new figures showing we received 183 complaints and 251 enquiries from consumers about the vehicle hire industry in the last two years – mostly to do with disputes over refunds and payment.

Consumer Protection recently learned of a couple of holidaymakers whose rental cars had been stolen and were being pursued for the full cost to replace the vehicles by the hire company, which claimed they had failed to adequately secure the keys.

While we investigate this matter, it's important for consumers know their rights and understand their obligations when hiring a vehicle.

Our advice is to shop around and read the hire contract carefully before you sign. The contract outlines rental, insurance and extra costs, and may have limits on your use of the vehicle and in-house insurance.

Rather than paying for a car rental company's excess reduction, a cheaper option may be to buy extra insurance from your own insurer or travel insurance provider. If there's loss or damage, then you would pay the excess to the car rental company and claim reimbursement from the insurer.

Some vehicle hire contracts may include you agreeing for unlimited charges being made to your credit card, so it's important to find out in what circumstances and amounts this might occur.

Before signing a contract, it is important to check for damage both inside and outside of the vehicle. Take photos of any damage and ensure it is recorded in the contract and counter-signed by the company representative.

Ensure there is a full tank of petrol before you drive away and find out whether you need to bring the vehicle back with a full tank and what the charge is per litre if you don't.

Upon returning the car, it is smart to ask for a written statement from the company noting that the car was returned undamaged. If damage did occur during the rental period, then make sure a written statement is made with the company about costs and procedures for repairs before leaving the premises.

### Home buyer grants help new owners

Taking that step from renting to buying your first home is one of life's biggest milestones, but the costs can quickly add up. As well as funding a deposit and organising a home loan, first home buyers also need to cover expenses such as settlement, lending institution fees and mortgage costs.

That's where the State Government's Home Buyer's Assistance Account (HBAA) scheme administered by Consumer Protection can help, by reimbursing some of the expenses of buying a first home in the shape of a grant worth up to \$2,000 for eligible applicants.

We understand new homeowners often spend the money on furniture, landscaping or establishing outdoor entertainment areas.

In a sign that it's not only established home owners or investors showing interest in the Western Australian property market, the scheme distributed a near record \$6.035 million last financial year to help 3,093 people buy their first home. The scheme is funded from interest derived from the trust accounts of real estate agents.

To receive a grant, applicants must meet certain criteria, including buying a property priced at \$400,000 or less that is required to be their primary residence for a minimum of 12 months.

It must be an established or partly built home, not an off-the-plan purchase, and applications must be submitted within 90 days of settlement, among other requirements.

In another homeownership initiative, the State Government has recently signed off on a 12-month extension of increased income limits for the Keystart home loan scheme.

To be eligible for a low-deposit home loan with Keystart, the income limits in regional areas (excluding Kimberley and Pilbara) are \$125,000 for singles, \$150,000 for couples and \$155,000 for families, for a property priced up to \$500,000.
