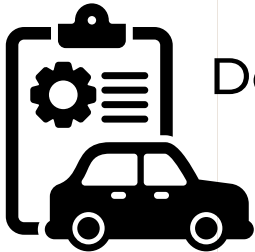

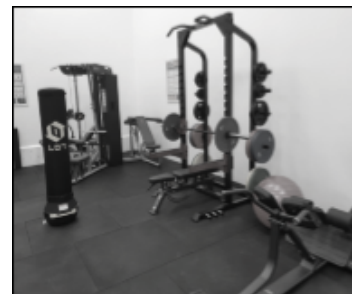


# The Three Springs Gym Is Open

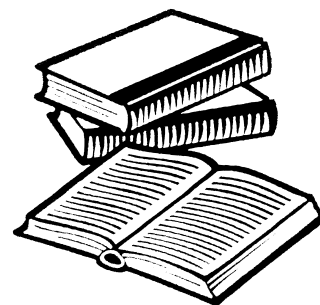

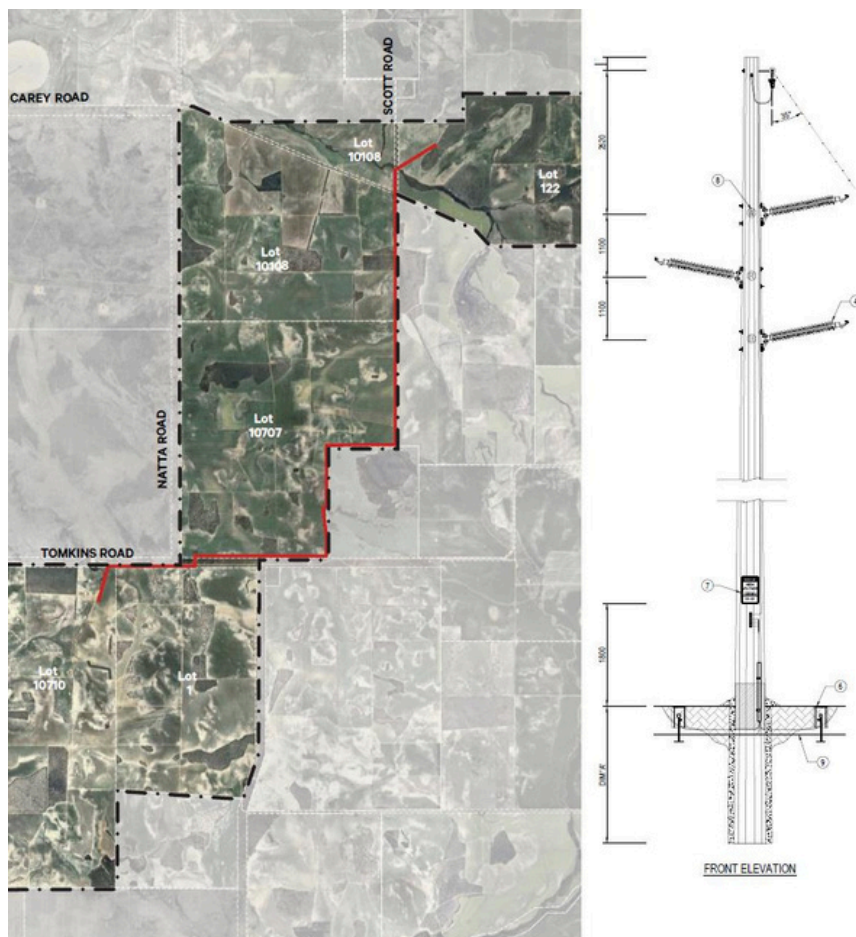

## October 2024 Rural Aid Article

People have an ability to choose their attitude. In any situation we can choose how we respond. This is unique and can be found not in always seeking happiness but instead seeking wholeness of self. Mind Body, Soul. Everything has something to teach us. Life does and will throw us challenges, life does and will give us grief, life has and will give us stress and life has and will show us happiness. There's no escaping these experiences. But there is always meaning in these experiences. That meaning can be realised at that moment and also later on when we look back and reflect on the event.

Understand that you are unique. As the only person who really knows you then it's up to you to be best 'me' you can and do what you believe is right. Live to your values, be who know you really are.

Our individual meaning of our existence goes in hand with our personal values. Our personal values help us move towards our personal life's desired goals. The following three statements describe how our personal life's values are achievable focusing on or realising that; 1. Life has meaning under all circumstances, 2. the main reason for living is our will and capacity to find meaning in life, 3. We in all situations have freedom to find meaning. Even in times of extreme hardship we have freedom and an ability to find a meaning to continue on. Even if this meaning is spiritual it's still a reason to continue walking forward. Spiritual is not confined to religion; it can be whatever you believe spirituality to be.

What's this about? This time of year, sees people getting very busy in various roles in our regions as the harvest and all the associated businesses of harvesting ramps up. Lambing, Calving, crutching and sales of stock before the end of year break makes us busier. A reminder to understand that being busier for some, not all, means being more stressed and tired, more tired means being less able to reason, less ability to reason opens the door to more negativity. More negativity leads to more stress and frustration.

We all have the ability to pause and reflect before we respond. This ability helps to stop the knee jerk reaction of saying or doing something in the moment. Afterwards you ponder, why did I do that? where did that come from? Why did I say that? When your body and mind are telling you something, listen. Accept the fact that you and only you are responsible for your reaction and attitude. No one is saying, 'hey you get frustrated and stressed now'. If someone close to you expresses concerns because they have noticed you appear different; not the person they know and love; then the same rule applies. Pause, reflect on why they feel they need to tell you this and accept it comes from their heart.

"If you are patient in a moment of anger, you will escape a hundred days of sorrow" (Chinese proverb)

This is not easy but it is a choice. I choose to follow the path towards my values not the alternative negative path some thoughts are asking me to take.

Sometimes our negative thoughts are too strong and we cannot see any light through the black clouds around us. This realisation is also a time to listen to your body and soul and seek help. Be strong seek help, be strong be that help. You will be surprised how many people actually do care when your negative thoughts are advising you otherwise.



# Andromeda Galaxy | October – December

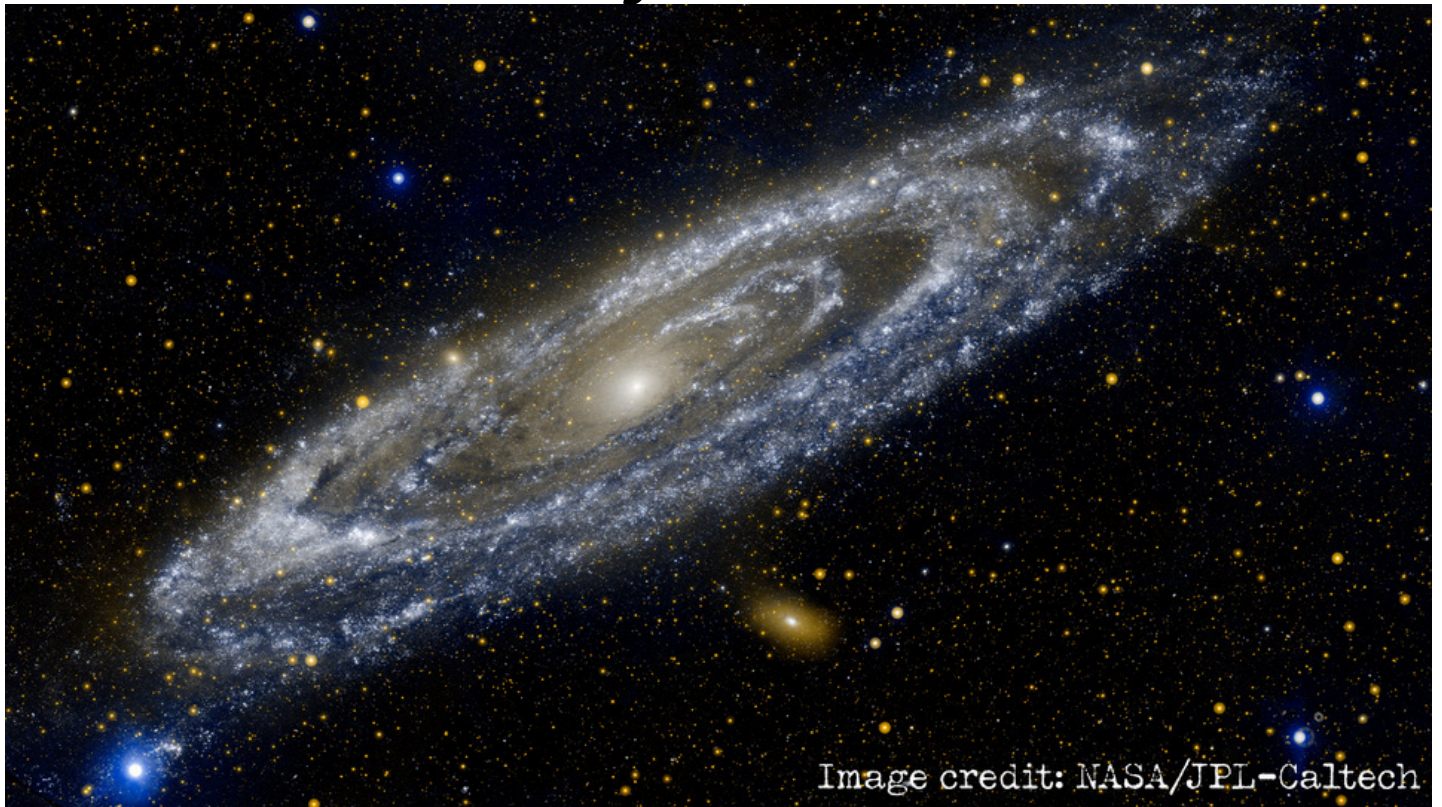

Andromeda is in our galactic neighbourhood of local galaxies. It's 2.5 million light years away and yet it's the most distant object visible to the human eye.

With the weather warming up, now is a great time to get out under a dark sky and explore your Universe. Through winter, the orientation of Earth allows us to look into the centre of our own galaxy, but in summer, we look away from the centre, allowing us to search for other galaxies.

The Milky Way is part of a group of galaxies that are all linked together by the pull of gravity, called the Local Group. There are about 54 galaxies in our Local Group. These are mostly dwarf galaxies clustered around the 3 largest of Milky Way, Andromeda, and Triangulum.

November is the best time to see Andromeda. It's always thought to have been larger than our Milky Way galaxy. However, research published by the University of Western Australia node of the International Centre for Radio Astronomy Research (ICRAR) estimates that Andromeda is the same size as the Milky Way or perhaps even slightly smaller. [Read the research for yourself here.](#)

You will need a very dark sky with no moonlight and a clear view to the northern horizon to see Andromeda. Using a star chart or a free online tool like [SkySafari AR](#) or [Stellarium](#) will help you find Andromeda.

First, using a star chart or app, search for and locate the star called Mirach low on the northern horizon. Use this star and the pattern of fainter stars that are below and to the left of Mirach to try and locate Andromeda with the naked-eye.

## When and where to look:

**From 11pm, between 25th September – 6th October**

**From 10pm, between 24th October – 4th November**

**From 9pm, between 23rd November – 4th December**

Look low on the northern horizon. Unfortunately, because it lies so far north, Andromeda will never rise more than 16° above the horizon making it very difficult to see from Perth.

## For Telescopes and Binoculars

Andromeda looks like a small, faint, misty oval shaped object in medium sized telescopes.

## Remember

To see this deep space object with the unaided eye, practice using averted vision to tease out the faint light. If you focus on a nearby star, it should make it easier to spot Andromeda out of the corner of your eye.

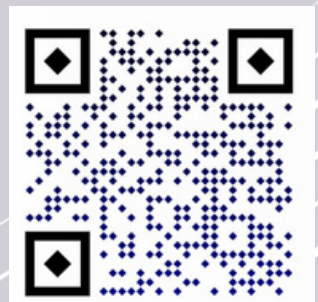

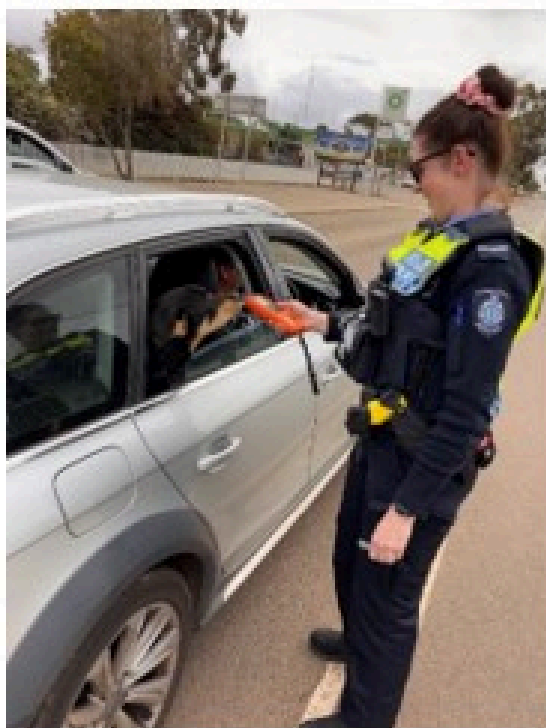




## POLICE NOTES

## What is Energy Ahead?

Energy Ahead is a program that helps participants to take control of their energy use, helping them to:

- Understand and confidently use energy within their household
- Reduce their energy use and costs
- Have a positive impact on the environment



## Why is it Free?

Energy Ahead is funded as a commitment of the Western Australian Climate Policy. The program is delivered by the Financial Wellbeing Collective in collaboration with Synergy which means all of our services are free for residential Synergy customers.

### Household Energy Audits – In Home

Energy Coaches provide in home energy audits to help participants understand and manage their energy use. They receive a report with customised tips on how to take control and reduce energy use along with various energy efficiency items to get them started. Audits take about 2 hours and can be delivered Monday to Friday within business hours.



### Household Energy Audits - Virtual

Our Energy Coaches can also provide virtual audits which require participants to have an active internet connection and a mobile or tablet with a camera.



### Energy Coaching

Energy Coaching is a practical way for participants to learn more about their household energy use and how they can make positive changes to reduce use and costs. We provide a number of coaching sessions over 1 or 2 Synergy bill cycles along with a report with customised tips on how to take control and reduce energy use.



### Community Workshops

We run community workshops to help participants to understand and manage their household energy use. We provide practical energy saving tips that can help them to reduce their electricity bills and get ahead. 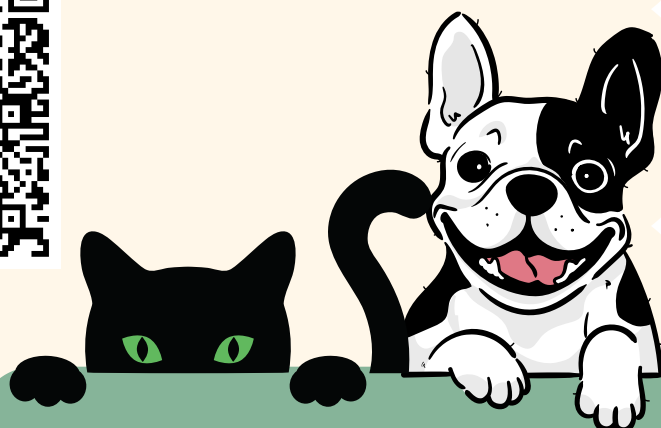

## DID YOU KNOW?

### Laws for Responsible Dog Owners

#### Your responsibilities

**Dog control Penalty:** \$200 to \$5,000 If you own a dog, you have a legal responsibility to keep it under control, either within a fenced area on your property or on a leash when in public.

**Dogs barking** Penalty: \$200 to \$5,000 As a dog owner, you are responsible for ensuring that your dog is not creating a public nuisance by barking excessively. Nuisance barking also covers public places adjoining the premises.

**Removal of dog droppings** Penalty: Varies Dog droppings are a source of annoyance to other users of footpaths and recreation areas. Most local governments have local laws that require the person in charge of the dog in a public place to remove their dog's droppings and adequately dispose of it.

**Penalties for dog attacks** Penalty: \$3,000 to \$20,000 Potential imprisonment A dog attack is a very serious matter. If your dog attacks a person or another animal, you will be held responsible even if you are not there at the time.

**Dog registration** Penalty: \$200 A dog owner is legally required to register his or her dog with the appropriate local government if it is more than three months old. Contact your local government for a registration form and list of applicable fees.

**Registration tags** Penalty: \$200 Your dog is required to wear a collar to which must be attached a valid registration tag. This tag will be issued by your local government when you pay your registration fee

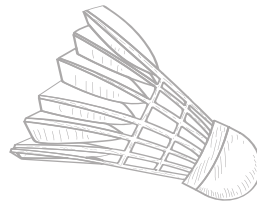
