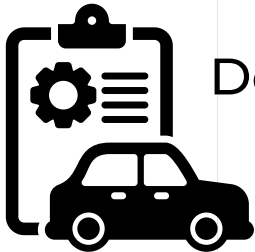

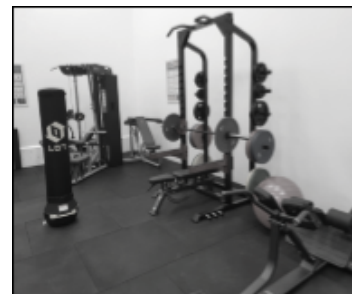


The Three Springs Gym Is Open

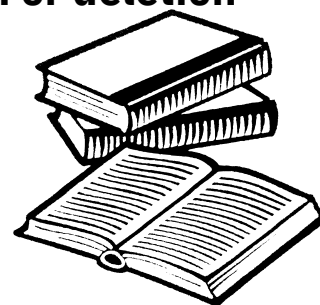

WHY VOLUNTEER? By donating your time you can make a real difference and give something back to your community. Not only do you get the satisfaction of helping others, but you also gain important skills and experience. No matter what your motivation, being a St John Ambulance Volunteer is a great way to get involved in your community and help change lives.

WHAT'S INVOLVED? Driving ambulances, transporting patients, providing first aid are just a few of the roles when you volunteer with St John Ambulance. As a volunteer you will be supported every step of the way and given all the training necessary to fulfill your role. You nominate the time you can give, day, night, weekends- there are no time constraints.

Training is conducted to a level at which you feel comfortable, confident and ready to assist.

Country Ambulance Volunteer Pathway – we have three pathways YOU can choose the pathway or scope of practice that YOU are comfortable with

Emergency Medical Responder EMR: the start of your clinical training with St John and covers Infection Control, Patient Movement, Patient extrication and skills to use the stretcher, wheelchair and lifting equipment, scene safety, CPR, Ambulance Driving, transporting a patient in the ambulance.

You will require a First Aid Certificate, National Police Clearance, unencumbered C class Drivers License and be at least 18 years of age and will need to attend a two day training course to acquire certification as a EMR Officer. You can if you wish up scope to a higher level, but no pressure – its your choice .

Emergency Medical Assistant EMA – the pre-requisite is to have the scope of a EMR and be able to attend a four day training course.

As a EMA you are trained in patient assessment, airway management, ambulance documentation & Communication, Medication awareness and checks, Disaster management and Triage, Introduction to Trauma and Spinal awareness, CPR, Defib Familiarisation, Infection Control & Safety

Emergency Medical Technician EMT : pre-requisite EMA and 12 month volunteering as a EMA – this course involves EMT 1 – online learning and EMT 2 – four days of face to face learning and assessment.

When scoped as a EMT you expand on your skills and knowledge as a EMA extending on Patient assessment with medical and trauma patients, administration of medications to both medical and trauma patients, skills in the management of fractures, Obstetrics (Childbirth) Resuscitation CPR skills, Disaster management, Documentation & Communication.

There is no pressure to up scope through skill levels.

Our Sub Centre :North Midlands embracing the communities of Three Springs, Carnamah, Coorow and Eneabba need community members to volunteer to assist us to deliver a Ambulance service to our community, the people we are providing the service to are YOUR family, friends and associates – we need two Officers to crew a ambulance to help others. You can be one of those Officers

As a Community we need to take ownership for volunteering to provide this service or we just won't have a ambulance Service to help those we love and care about

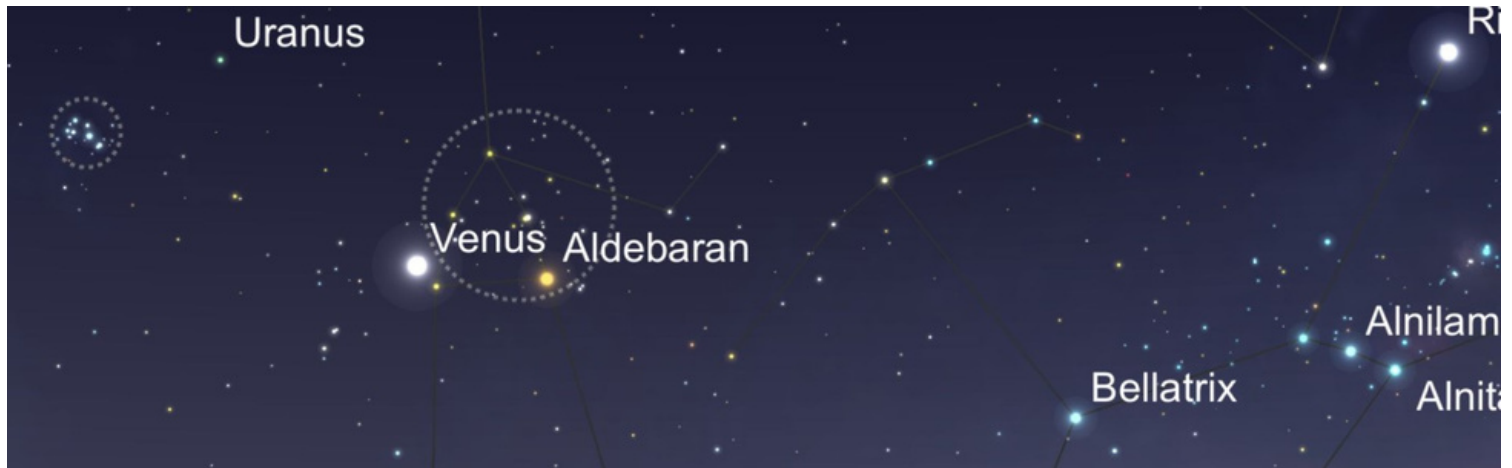

TAURUS IS A LARGE CONSTELLATION AND IF YOU USE A STARGAZING APP, YOU MIGHT BE ABLE TO MAKE OUT ALL THE STARS OF THE CONSTELLATION WITH THE HORNS REACHING OUT QUITE A WAY!

The Southern delta-Aquarids Meteor Shower usually produces faint meteors, and observing meteor showers can already be tough at the best of times. Getting the best out of a meteor shower requires late nights, dark skies, a little luck, and lots of patience. The shower's peak coincides with the moon in its first quarter this year, so the skies are almost at their darkest, we recommend you make the most of it and head out to an [Astrotourism Town in country WA](#).

When and where to look:

The Southern delta-Aquarids Meteor Shower is active from 12th July to 28th August. The peak of about 25 meteors/hour is from 10pm on 30th July, with the best viewing around 2am on 31st July when the radiant point is high in the sky and the moon has long since set.

The Southern delta-Aquarids Meteor Shower appears to radiate from the constellation of Aquarius. This means the meteors will appear to emanate from a point high in the north eastern sky.

Extended Warranties: worth it or worthless?

Scored a bargain on a new TV, washing machine or fridge lately? But with the purchase often comes the question, "would you like to add an extended warranty?" It might sound like a smart move for extra peace of mind in case something goes wrong. But before you hand over more money, it's worth taking a closer look at what you're really getting. Because in many cases, the Australian Consumer Law (ACL) may already cover you.

The ACL entitles you to have a faulty product repaired or replaced, or you can even get a refund or compensation (depending on whether the fault is a 'major' or 'minor' failure). You have these ACL entitlements, regardless of any extended warranty, and even if the manufacturer's warranty has expired. Be wary of any retailer that tells you otherwise.

Effectively, an extended warranty could mean you're paying for cover you're already getting.

So, before you sign up and pay up for an extended warranty, understand what you're buying.

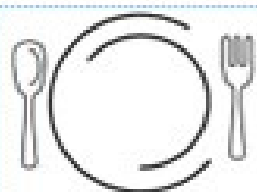
Ask the salesperson to explain the actual benefits beyond your automatic, and free, ACL rights to a refund, product replacement, or repair. It is illegal for a retailer to mislead you into buying an extended warranty for rights you already have under the ACL.

Ask if call-out fees are extra under the extended warranty. Are labour and installation costs extra? Are you limited to the repairer you can use if something goes wrong with your item? Compare the cost of the warranty against the cost of your item. Remember that you already have rights under Australia's consumer laws, whether or not you buy an extended warranty.

Always check the rules, as some claims during the manufacturer's warranty could cancel the extended warranty that you paid extra for.

Stay alert to high pressure sales tactics sometimes used to convince you to pay extra for an extended warranty and take note that retailers may also rebrand them as "product care".

An extended warranty might offer you extra peace of mind, but it might not always deliver the coverage and protection you're expecting. And if you feel you're being pressured to purchase an extended warranty, you can contact Consumer Protection on 1300 30 40 54 to report the incident.
