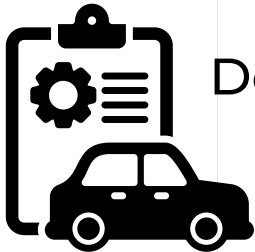

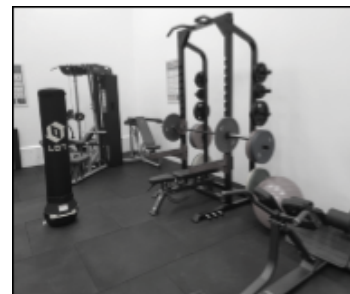

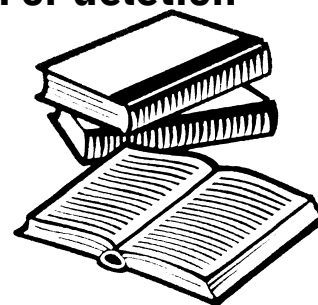

Farewell Message from Keith Woodward,

Chief Executive Officer, Shire of Three Springs.



After almost six years of service as the Chief Executive Officer of the Shire of Three Springs, I have resigned. Since commencing in November 2019, it has been my privilege to work alongside Councillors, staff, and the wider community to deliver projects and initiatives that will continue to benefit Three Springs well into the future.

Together, we have had remarkable progress. Since 2020, the Shire has secured more than \$14.5 million in grant funding, enabling us to deliver major projects that strengthen community wellbeing, diversify our economy, and support long-term sustainability.

Guided by the Strategic Community Plan, our major milestones include:

- The \$11.5 million Mid-West Secondary Grain Freight Routes Project, in partnership with Main Roads WA, upgrades key freight routes supporting our agricultural sector.
- Completing the Town Planning Scheme Review, ensuring sustainable and well-planned development.
- Progress on the Gooch Street Subdivision to support future industry and government accommodation needs while supporting local businesses.
- Redevelopment/new civil and community facilities, including the Railway Road upgrade, Shire Hall renovations, Incident Control Centre, Community Gym, netball courts with lighting, Aquatic Centre lighting, and Dominican Park.
- Delivery of innovative tourism initiatives, including the Three Springs Silo Projections, which transformed the decommissioned silos into Western Australia's largest outdoor projection surface. Planning for the Duffy's Store redevelopment.
- Hosting and supporting 27 major community events since 2021, including Australia Day celebrations, Remembrance Day services, International Women's Day, Stargazing Nights, Off Road Racing Weekends, Get Online Week, Christmas Movie Nights, and landmark Silo Projection events that brought residents and visitors together.
- Community-focused initiatives, including new library technology, Lovelocks water harvesting systems, and assisting with establishing the Three Springs Catchment Group.
- Secured medical services in partnership with WA Country Health Service. This collaboration has ensured a consistent medical presence at the Three Springs Medical Practice, which provides care for the communities of Three Springs, Carnamah, and Coorow. It also provided an emergency doctor for the Three Springs Hospital, strengthening local health services and supporting community wellbeing.

Three Springs is set to play a pivotal role in the Midwest and Gascoyne's next growth phase. With more than \$5 billion in planned energy, mining, and infrastructure investments across the region, at least 17 major projects are proposed to affect our Shire directly. Three Springs is well-positioned to benefit from new economic opportunities, workforce demand, and regional partnerships. Projects such as renewable energy developments, workforce housing initiatives, and industrial land planning will boost local business and employment and cement our place as a strategic hub in Western Australia's transition to clean energy and diversified industries.

These achievements have only been possible through the shared vision and commitment of a united Council and dedicated, hardworking Shire staff.

Three Springs is a resilient and forward-looking community. I am proud of what we have accomplished together and confident that the Shire will continue to thrive under new leadership.

I thank President Chris Lane, the Councillors I have served alongside, our staff, and the broader community of Three Springs. It has been an honour to serve as your Chief Executive Officer.

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINARY ELECTION
CLOSE OF ENROLMENTS
Shire of Three Springs
ROLL CLOSE: 5:00 PM Friday, 22 August 2025**

You may be eligible to be enrolled to vote in the local government elections on 18 October 2025 if you live in or are an owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Three Springs.

Residents

You are automatically enrolled to vote if you are on the State Electoral Roll as at 5:00 PM Friday, 22 August 2025. If you are not already on the State Electoral Roll and meet the eligibility criteria, or if you have changed address recently, you must complete an enrolment form.

Enrolment Forms

You can enrol or update your details online, or download an enrolment form, via the Western Australian Electoral Commission website (www.elections.wa.gov.au/enrol). Forms are also available from the Australian Electoral Commission (www.aec.gov.au). Enrolments and updates must be completed and received by 5:00 PM Friday, 22 August 2025.

Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers

If you are a non-resident owner or occupier of rateable property in the Shire of Three Springs and are on the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, you are eligible to enrol to vote. Owners of land who were on the last Local Government roll continue to retain that status until they cease to own the rateable property to which the enrolment relates. Occupiers do not have continuous enrolment and should contact the Shire of Three Springs to confirm their enrolment status. To be eligible to enrol as an occupier, you will need to have a right of continuous occupation under a lease, tenancy agreement or other legal instrument for at least the next three months following the date of the application to enrol and have paid rent for at least the prescribed amount.

Joint Owners and Occupiers

If a rateable property is owned or occupied by more than two people, a majority of the owners/occupiers may nominate two persons from amongst themselves who are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll, to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Corporations

A body corporate that owns or occupies rateable property may nominate two people who are officers of the body corporate that are on either the State or Commonwealth Electoral Roll to enrol as owner/occupier electors.

Enrolment Forms – Non-Resident Owners and Occupiers Only

Enrolment forms can be obtained from local governments and must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer by 5:00 PM Friday, 22 August 2025. Further information can be obtained from the Shire of Three Springs.

Have your say: Is WA's funeral pricing code working?

Saying goodbye is never easy. The last thing families need is confusion or stress about how much a funeral will cost. Whether it's a joyful tribute or a solemn farewell, the pricing must be clear and upfront.

In Western Australia, the Funeral Pricing Code of Practice means funeral directors must publicly display their prices for all services and packages on their website and each place of business so you can compare the costs yourself in the comfort of your home or with friends and family.

A basic package of the least expensive combination of essential goods and services must also be included in the public pricing. This is so people have a better understanding of the costs for the minimum legal requirements for a burial or cremation.

Once you have decided on what sort of sendoff your loved one will have and ask for a quote, you should receive a full breakdown of prices within two business days to know exactly what the total cost will be, so there are no surprises later on.

Grieving friends and family deserve to be protected when they are at their most vulnerable.

Those consumers who decide to pay for their funerals upfront before they are needed should know they are protected by the mandatory Prepaid Funerals Code of Practice. This requires a detailed contract, prices to be fixed at the time of signing, a 30-day cooling off period and payments to prepaid funeral funds to be managed within secure investments under the name of the client until they are required.

It's important to note that prepaid funeral cover is different to funeral insurance, which should be treated with caution given ongoing payments are required for the rest of a consumer's life. This means they could pay significantly more than the actual payment their family will receive.

Funeral bonds are a n investment product where you make regular payments over time and the value grows. When the time comes, the money can only be used for a funeral.

Funeral insurance and bonds are not covered by either Code of Practice, they are regulated by the Australian Securities and Investments Commission (ASIC) as they are financial products.

Reforms to the funeral industry began in 2022 to stamp out unscrupulous sales practices and overcharging. Before the Funeral Pricing Code of Practice came into effect on 1 May 2023 the cost sometimes wasn't known until after the funeral was held, leading family and friends of the deceased to believe they had been overcharged.

Some people ended up with bells and whistles they didn't want or need or couldn't afford. Confusing 'bundles' with no itemised prices meant comparing costs between funeral directors was impossible.

From time to time, State Government departments must conduct reviews of laws. That time has come for the Funeral Pricing Code of Practice and Consumer Protection would like your help by filling out the survey here: <https://consumerprotection.wa.gov.au/funeralpricing>

The purpose of the survey is to get feedback on whether the code is working and if consumers are getting upfront knowledge of the prices of funeral goods and services and other funeral information.

If you believe you have been misled about funeral costs, report it to Consumer Protection on 1300 30 40 54.

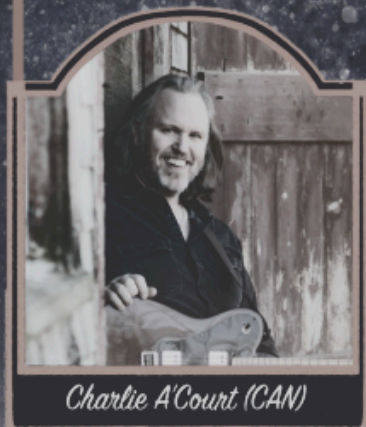
